#### General Description:

The RS-13011 portable stand is designed to help you minimize fatigue and discomfort to enjoy your time after work. The RS-13011 portable stand enables easy and safe transport and use of The Rookie electric (RS-13003) and gas hose rollers (RS-13000/ 13004 /13005) and The Rookie ReLoader (RS-13002).

The RS-13011 portable stand is an assembly kit with all the main parts that you need to put it together. It includes tools that enable you to assemble the stand components without additional tools. The main parts of the RS-13011 include four flat-free wheels, left and right side plates, front and back plates, a handle for moving the stand, and two sets of axles for the front and rear wheels.

The RS-13011 has four durable flat-free wheels: two front and two back wheels. The front wheels are on a caster and have brakes already set up.

The RS-13011 comes with side panels that make up the sides of the stand. The back panel is designed with a support latch onto which the hose rollers or the ReLoader is attached. The front panel is designed with holes for quick-release pins that hold the hose rollers or the ReLoader to the stand.
